A. EXPLANATORY NOTES TO THE INTERIM FINANCIAL STATEMENTS - MFRS 134

A1 Basis of Preparation and Accounting Policies

The interim financial statements are unaudited and have been prepared in accordance with the requirements as set out in Malaysian Financial Reporting Standards ('MFRS') No. 134: Interim Financial Reporting and paragraph 9.22 of the Main Market Listing Requirements of Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad ("Bursa Securities").

The interim financial statements should be read in conjunction with the Group's annual audited financial statements for the year ended 31 December 2014. The explanatory notes attached to the condensed consolidated interim financial statements provide an explanation of events and transactions that are significant to an understanding of the changes in the financial position and performance of the Group since the year ended 31 December 2014.

The significant accounting policies and methods of computation adopted for the interim financial statements are consistent with those adopted for the annual financial statements for the year ended 31 December 2014, except for the adoption of the following revised Malaysian Financial Reporting Standards (MFRSs) which are effective for annual periods beginning on or after 1 January 2015.

B1 Review of Performance

The Group registered higher revenue of RM15.3 million and RM53.4 million for the current quarter and period to date respectively, as compared to RM14.5 million and RM48.1 million for the preceding year corresponding quarter and period to date. In tandem therewith, profit before taxation also came in higher at RM1.2 million and RM4.5 million for the current quarter and period to date respectively, as compared to loss before taxation of RM0.4 million and profit before taxation of RM1.5 million for the preceding year corresponding quarter and period to date.

The increase in revenue for the current quarter and period to date was mainly attributable to both higher sales volume and selling prices for the Group's brick products. In addition, the shut down of one of the production lines for upgrading purpose, which lasted for about one month in the third quarter of last year had also resulted in both lower production and sales volume.

B2 <u>Material Change in Profit Before Taxation for the Current Quarter compared to the Immediate Preceding Quarter</u>

The Group recorded profit before taxation of RM1.2 million for the current quarter as compared to profit before taxation of RM1.6 million for the immediate preceding quarter. The decline in profit before taxation was primarily due to lower sales volume for the majority of the Group's brick products for the quarter under review.

B3 Commentary on Prospects

Malaysia's economy continued its downtrend growth this year, gross domestic product ("GDP") expanded by 4.7% in the third quarter as compared to the first quarter of 5.6% and the second quarter of 4.9%, supported mainly by domestic demand and private sector activity. Private consumption however saw a more moderate growth of 4.1% in the third quarter as compared to the second quarter of 6.4% this year as households continued to adjust the impact from the implementation of the Goods and Services Tax ("GST"). Against this backdrop, sentiment in the real property sector had shown signs of cooling with fewer new project launches and the management anticipates that going forward, demand in the construction and residential sub-sector would also moderate in tandem. Nonetheless, the Management is still hopeful that with no foreseeable additional production capacity coming on stream in the market, supply of clay bricks would continue to be well absorbed by market demand.

In facing the challenging times ahead, the Management will continue its effort in improving cost efficiency and optimizing productivity, and the Group will strive to achieve satisfactory financial results for the year 2015.
